 - Any uncertainties remaining that need to be addressed through future research?



Brainstorming: Second order integrative papers

- Carbon-water interactions in planted pine
 - Incorporate sap flow; WaSSI; Regional C models
- Management effects on ecosystem C
 - Incorporate soil respiration, Tier I, II, Tier III analyses
- Ensemble modeling of pine productivity
 - 3-PG, G&Y, CLM, DayCENT
- SRTS modeling
- Process paper
 - Interdisciplinarity; Research/outreach interaction; social network analysis
